

Flathead Lake Home and Cabin

The home and cabin are perched atop a sloping site on the western shore of Flathead Lake in northern Montana. Square cut, dovetail logs and native stone create a rustic character that is anchored to the site by a series of stacked boulder walls. The great room contrasts the timber structure with a continuous boulder wall of glass to capture views. A full width porch continues the reach of the home, a true outdoor room to enjoy lazy afternoons and morning coffee.

The guest cabin is a cozy 400 square feet and welcomes visitors to their own private quarters. A boathouse complements the homes' architecture and is a popular spot to hang out on hot summer days.
